Exhibition "Baia Mare Artistic Center.

The Fascination of Renewal.1896-2017"

The exhibition offers the opportunity to become acquainted with a fascinating artistic

phenomenon, which is unique in Romania and exceptional in Central Europe. Throughout its

existence, spanning more than 100 years (1896-2017), the "Baia Mare Artistic Center" has

had a permanent dialogue with the main trends of modern art, from Post-Impressionism to the

late Avant-garde and Postmodernism, while also expressing the local paniters' specific visual

language.

Over 3500 artists from Central and Eastern Europe, as well as from further West or

East have been temporarily or permanently established in this city of painters and contributed

to its expansion with their creations. The exhibition's curator Tiberiu Alexa (manager at Baia

Mare Art Museum) explains that the "Baia Mare Artistic Center" was based on an open

transnational multicultural dialogue and defines its identity as a fundamental pan-European

one. This artistic "colony" of painters had a significant impact on the city's community,

determining a reshaping in mentality and a better understanding of the cultural value which

visual arts can yield.

This exhibition is the result of a fruitful collaboration between the Baia Mare Artistic

Center and the Brasov Art Museum and represents an exceptional cultural event. The curator

Tiberiu Alexa, an expert on this artistic phenomenon, made a competent and comprehensive

selection of artworks and brought a complex and nuanced overview regarding the evolution of

the "Baia Mare Artistic Center" starting with its founder, Simon Hollósy (1896), and going

further to the contemporary artists, whose works are exhibited in the last room.

Artworks signed by some of Braşov's artists who created in Baia Mare such as:

Arthur Coulin, Emerich Tamás, Gustav Kollár, Hermann Morres, Hans Mattis-Teutsch and

Ioan Mattis are also present in the exhibition.
